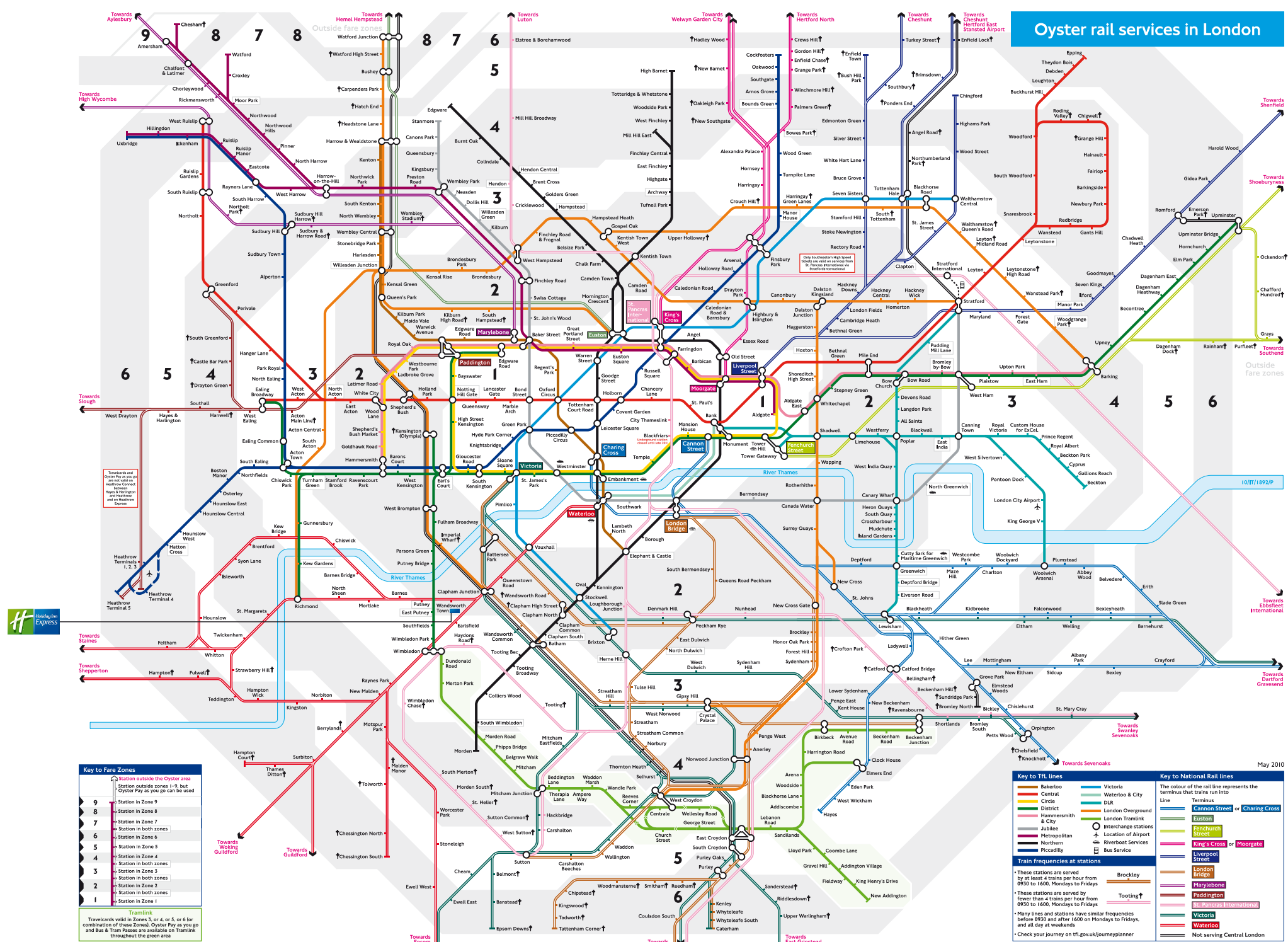


Oyster rail services in London



Key to Fare Zones

Station outside the Oyster area
Station outside zones 1-9, but Oyster Pay as you go can be used

- 9 Station in Zone 9
- 8 Station in Zone 8
- 7 Station in Zone 7
- 6 Station in both zones 6 & 7
- 5 Station in Zone 5
- 4 Station in Zone 4
- 3 Station in both zones 3 & 4
- 2 Station in Zone 2
- 1 Station in both zones 1 & 2

Tramlink
Travelcards valid in Zones 3, 4, or 5, or 5, or 6 (or combination of these Zones). Oyster Pay as you go and Bus & Tram Passes are available on Tramlink throughout the green area

Train frequencies at stations

- These stations are served by at least 4 trains per hour from 0930 to 1600, Mondays to Fridays
- These stations are served by fewer than 4 trains per hour from 0930 to 1600, Mondays to Fridays
- Many lines and stations have similar frequencies before 0930 and after 1600 on Mondays to Fridays, and all day at weekends
